'**ALL** pupils leaving primary school **physically literate** and with the **knowledge, skills and motivation** necessary to equip them for a **healthy, active lifestyle** and **lifelong participation** in physical activity and sport.

The Government is continuing to providing funding of £150 million per annum for all primary schools in the country. This funding is being provided by the Departments of Education, Health and Culture and Media and Sport. The money will go to primary schools to spend on improving the quality of PE and Sport for all their children.

Aims for 2016-17

During the academic year 2015-16 we received £8855.50 and we will be receiving a similar figure this academic year.

At Park Street, we look carefully each year at our current provision to ensure our children get maximum benefit from the funding. We have spoken to staff and the children about what we do now and how we can improve our provision in the future.

We aim to:

1. At least maintain the number of clubs offered for all key stages.
2. Continue to look at the range of sports and activities we offer to try to engage as many children in sport as possible.
3. To fund 50% of clubs for disadvantaged pupil. (The other 50% coming from disadvantaged funding)

4. Employ specialist coaches to teach their sport during curriculum time and provide valuable CPD for staff.
5. Ensure all staff access training, to widen their skill knowledge and experience.
6. Offer top-up swimming to those children who are unable to swim 25 metres at the end of Y3.
7. To increase the number of Inter-house competitions organised throughout the year.
8. Ensure there is good quality equipment for all activities.
